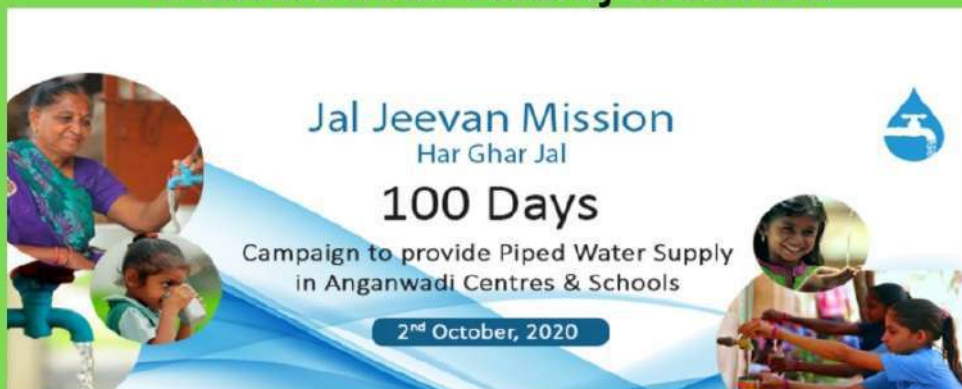
RTMs installed in 6 Common Effluent Treatment plants in and around Bangalore with Karnataka State Pollution Control Board support.

Centre's campaign to ensure water security in schools



A 100-days campaign is in progress to ensure water security in all schools and Anganwadi centres in India under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM). The campaign was launched on 2nd October 2020, by Shri. Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Minister of Jal Shakti, Government of India on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti.

This campaign was envisaged by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 29th September 2020 while releasing the 'Margdarshika' for Gram Panchayats and Paani Samitis for implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM). During the occasion he told that ensuring safe water to children is a priority, as they are the most vulnerable to water-borne diseases.

The campaign, aims to provide piped water supply in Anganwadi Centres, Ashramshalas (tribal residential hostels for children) and schools essentially highlights water, sanitation and hygiene issues and its interplay with children's well-being and their long-term development.

The campaign also aims to discuss and bring awareness among rural community, anganwadi workers, school teachers, school management committees, etc about the importance of Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH).
